Oriah, a teen from Netivot, was injured on October 7th by a mortar shell and lost two toes, leaving her with severe nerve pain that made standing for long periods unbearable. PELE engineers designed a custom sandal insert that dramatically reduced her discomfort, allowing her

In 2024, two PELEthons—intensive innovation sprints—brought together volunteers and experts to tackle accessibility challenges in just a few hours.

The **Tefillin PELEthon** developed assistive devices for soldiers who lost limbs, enabling them to lay tefillin independently.

The **Young Innovators PELEthon** led to creative solutions like a darbukaplaying system for children with limited hand mobility, a hands-free way to use a smartphone while walking with crutches, and an umbrella-opening mechanism for wheelchair users.
